

# Young Adult & Campus Ministry Public Events Grant

Awards from the YACM Public Events Grant are for the purpose of assisting congregations in offering large public programs, such as lectures or workshops, on college and university campuses, and in congregations. The primary goal of these programs is to increase awareness of and interest in the Unitarian Universalist movement. YACM Public Events Grants (up to \$2000) are made at the discretion of the Director of Young Adult and Campus Ministry and require the applicant to provide detailed information about the presentation/program for which the award will be used.

### Criteria for Judgment

Applications for YACM Public Events Grants will be judged on the following criteria:

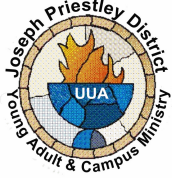
- Role of the event in gathering or sustaining a Unitarian Universalist young adult or campus group
- Degree to which the proposed event reflects the Principles and Purposes of the Unitarian Universalism
- Potential for the event to raise awareness of Unitarian Universalism or Unitarian Universalist values and principles on the campus and in the local community
- Involvement of local Unitarian Universalist congregation(s) in the event
- Potential for the event to realistically meet the goals set for it
- Potential for the event to address issues of oppression and marginalization in our society and accountability of event to historically marginalized groups
- Fair Share giving by the applicant congregation to the UUA Annual Program Fund and the JPD District Dues.

### Grant Application Deadlines

The JPD Young Adult and Campus Ministry Program offers a number of grants for local congregations and groups. We are always seeking to fund innovative, accountable and sustainable young adult programs around the district. Grant applications received by the following deadline will be given first priority for review. Grant applications received after the deadline will still be reviewed, but with lower priority for the available funding.

<b>For Programs Beginning:</b>	<b>Priority Deadline</b>
<b>July 1 – Aug 31</b>	March 1
<b>Sept 1 – Dec 31</b>	July 1
<b>Jan 1 – June 30</b>	October 1

All grants require that the congregation applying be a Fair Share contributor to the UUA Annual Program Fund and the JPD District Dues in the most recently completed fiscal year.
